Shepherd's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

These are the instructions to help us transition into an open St. Aloysius Church beginning Tuesday 16 June:

Fr. Novokowsky's points:

1. Your first concern should NOT be your physical well-being; this is secondary to your spiritual well-being. Coming to Mass involves some risk, just as St. Aloysius put himself in mortal danger to care for the sick.
2. Fear of getting sick is only reasonable given the real (not merely rumored) evidence at hand. Very few people in the Niagara Region are getting sick or remaining sick.
3. The government downplays the role of health in preventing serious infection. Exposure and infection do not necessarily follow.
4. We will try to continue to live-stream the Mass for those unwilling or unable to attend.

Points from the Diocese of St. Catharines:

1. Welcome back to Holy Mass! Thank the Lord!
2. The dispensation from the Sunday Obligation of Mass attendance is still in effect.
3. If you are sick or experiencing symptoms of sickness, please stay home. If your pastor is likewise feeling sick, Holy Mass will be cancelled.
4. For now, the max is 30% building capacity.
5. Practice Social Distancing always: 6 feet apart, every third pew.
6. Listen to the Ushers.
7. Be reasonable, responsible, generous, and patient with your neighbour.
8. Use of masks and gloves is recommended. Bring your own.
9. Use hand sanitizer.
10. Cough and Sneeze into your sleeve.
11. There will be no hymnals, no printed bulletins, and no handouts.
11. Love your neighbour. Judge not lest thou be judged.
