



## Shepherd's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

We spoke last week about conspiracies in general. One deserves special mention: The Freemasons.\* Founded in 1717, the Church has condemned this secret movement ever since. The freemasons are an organized resistance to the Catholic Church and the One True God. Their method is create chaos and then fill the void with their new evil 'order' of an alternative religion.

**Engineered chaos.** Ever wonder who is pushing the modern insanities of abortion, infanticide, euthanasia, gender ideology, the LGBT agenda, same sex marriage, destructive sex-ed, and climate change, etc.? These only make sense as building blocks of a sinister plan: destroy God's order.
