Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for your patience as we react and survive the latest onslaught of bullying from the provincial government. As we know, bullies are only encouraged by acquiescence. I encourage you to be involved as good citizens in the democratic process. - Mandatory Face Mask Bylaw for Niagara:** All people in an indoor public space must wear a face mask. Some may have a medical exemption. Please see the posted bylaw for details.
- Province-Wide Lock Down:** Our number of congregants (including the priest and server) is limited to 10. Mass attendance will be by INVITATION ONLY for the time being. We cannot accept registrations for Mass at this time. Updates will be published by email.
- Rest in Peace:** In the charity of your prayers please remember the repose of the soul of Murray Barrett who passed away on Christmas Day, and the consolation of his wife Katherine, who also lost her son, Mark, on 14 September this year. The funeral Mass will be Thursday afternoon.
- Communion Service.** You will notice on the schedule on Sunday 3 January a “Service” at 1 pm. This will be a “drive-thru” service using the Padre Pio Shrine. Enter the parking lot through the back gate. Line up at the shrine. When you reach the head of the line (immediately outside the shrine), exit your car all together, enter the shrine, receive Communion, re-enter your car and depart the lot, allowing the next car to approach. This way only one family will be seen outside their cars at any one time. Indeed, it is more important to *appear* to be following the rules. The church will be open, but it will give the wrong impression if many people are seen milling about. Please pray before and after communion devotions “off campus.”
- Saturday Confession Time.** Please note the time this week from 4 to 5 pm. Only 10 people allowed in the church at any one time.
