Dear Parishioners,

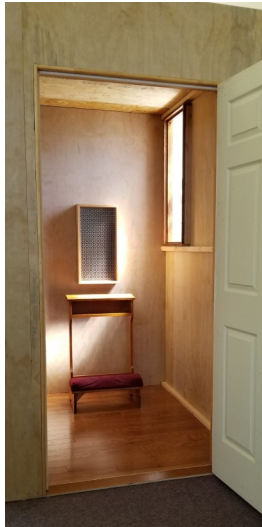
