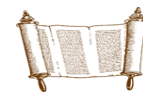

- New Assistant.** I am pleased to announce the arrival of Fr. Joseph Orłowski, FSSP. He will assist us here in the parish. Welcome Father! What does it mean to have a second priest? Will all services be doubled all the time? No. The first purpose of Father's presence here is priestly fraternity with the pastor. The second purpose is service to the faithful. In addition, there will be times when one of us is unavailable for some reason (travel, retreats, holidays, sickness, etc.). It is easy for us to entertain unreasonable expectations in this regard. Thank you for your spiritual and material support, without which the benefit of father's presence would not be possible.
- Experimental Times.** Please pay close attention to the schedule on the facing page as we are making many adjustments and experiments. We apologize for the turmoil. (Lab rats of the world—unite!) We begin the new times this Sunday 7 Feb with 4 Masses and a Communion Service. Let us pray for patience with the changes; let us keep our eye on the God's great generosity and be thankful.
- New Saturday Routine begins 13 Sat.** Two Masses; four confession times and one communion service. Note: 10 am confessions end at 10:40 so that those coming for Mass have some preparation time. Thank you.
- Saturday Confession and Communion.** These take place in the church (not Padre Pio Shrine). Limit 10 people in the church at one time. Take a number as you enter the front door; replace the number as you leave. If more than 10 are present, please take turns. Thank you.
- Sunday 2:30 pm Communion Service.** A "drive-thru" service at the Padre Pio Shrine. Enter thru the back gate; line up at the shrine. One family outside their car at a time, please. Pray the Act of Contrition before arriving; and post-communion devotions after "off campus." In the shrine: an offertory basket is available. Masks.
- Solemn Adoration.** Now begins at 12 noon. Invitations/registrations are being sent by email. Send a note: [mass.registration@pm.me](mailto:mass.registration@pm.me) UWhen you arrive, park in the front, use the front door; take a number as you enter and replace it as you leave. Masks. Thank you.
