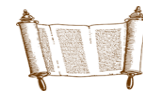

- Parking Lot Mass.** This is still in development. Please stay tuned.
- Ash Wednesday.** Day of Obligatory Fast and Abstinence, not obligatory Mass attendance. Two Masses and two Communion and Ash Services are available for your convenience. The “Services” will be the drive-thru variety at the Padre Pio Shrine. Enter by the back gate and line up as normal. Ashes will be received first at the designated kneeler, then Holy Communion at the second with the second priest. One may receive the ashes without receiving Holy Communion.
- Forty Hours Devotion!** Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament begins after Mass on Thurs., 18 Feb and goes until Benediction at 9 pm Fri., 19 Feb. (Masses during these times will interrupt the adoration without benediction.) Please commit to an hour or multiple hours here: <https://saintaloysiusparish.flocknote.com/signup/41383>
- Flock Note.** We are going to try to use this communication tool which is designed for churches to connect with their ... flock. Click the flock note link to sign up for the 40 Hours Devotion.
- Scheduling *ad experimentum*.** Please pay close attention to the schedule on the facing page. We apologize for the turmoil. Let us pray for patience with the changes.
- Saturday Confession and Communion.** These take place in the church (not Padre Pio Shrine). Limit 10 people in the church at one time. Take a number as you enter the front door; replace the number as you leave. If more than 10 are present, please take turns. Note: 10 am confessions end at 10:40 so that Mass goers have some preparation time. Thank you.
- Sunday 2:30 pm Communion Service.** A “drive-thru” service at the Padre Pio Shrine. Please enter thru the back gate; line up at the shrine. One family outside their car at a time. Pray the Act of Contrition before arriving, and post-communion devotions after “off campus.” In the shrine: an offertory basket is available. Masks.
- Family Day on Monday.** Please note the special Mass time of 11 am.
- Niagara Region** still in “lockdown” even as other areas of Ontario have opened up slightly. Therefore, our attendance rules remain the same.
