Dear Parishioners,

I turned on the CBC after a 9-month hiatus: the 6 pm news has devolved into a pandemic and vaccine infomercial. Wow. Disgust turned to sadness when I considered their viewership. How do the viewers know what they don't know?!

Vaccines. There are good medical reasons for refusing the vaccines. Effective treatments exist. Experts can explain. Please watch by Dr. Lee Merrit *

Morality. There are theological reasons for refusing. Some bishops agree. ** You may be confused about the pope's statements. Pope Francis said: "I believe that morally everyone must take the vaccine. It is the moral choice because it is about your life but also the lives of others. I do not understand why some say that this could be a dangerous vaccine ... why not take it?" (McElwee, NCR 11 Jan 2021).

I believe. When the pope says that he's giving his personal opinion. As such, we are free to disagree. Secondly, he means it when he says, 'I do not understand.' Obviously, he's been shielded from the chorus of people warning us about the known (and unknown) dangers of untested vaccines. *** CONGREGATION FOR THE DOCTRINE OF THE FAITH: Note on the morality of using some anti-Covid-19 vaccines (21 Dec. 2020.) "The fundamental reason for considering the use of these vaccines morally licit is that the kind of cooperation in evil (passive material cooperation) in the procured abortion from which these cell lines originate is, on the part of those making use of the resulting vaccines, remote. The moral duty to avoid such passive material cooperation is not obligatory **if there is a grave danger**, such as the otherwise uncontainable spread of a serious pathological agent." ... "In any case, from the ethical point of view, the morality of vaccination depends not only on the duty to protect one's own health, but also on the duty to pursue the common good. **In the absence of other means** to stop or even prevent the epidemic, the common good may recommend vaccination." 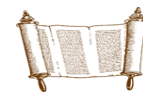
