- Sunday Mass Attendance.** We will be operating at a 10-person limit for the time-being, due to the new limitations. If you've been coming regularly this year, you're on our rotational list for Sundays. You'll be contacted when there is a seat for you at Sunday Mass.

- Communion Services.** No sign-up. On weekdays: take a number (1—10) before you walk in the main doors of church. On Sundays: **Now at 3pm.** Enter through back (Pilkington Street) gate and line up at pylons near main doors of church. A parking volunteer will let you know when it is your turn to proceed into church.
- Two Priest Rule:** When one priest is away, the 11 am Masses (current schedule) are cancelled. Please pay close attention to the weekly schedule.
- Saturday Classes.** Confirmation ceremonies are postponed, however, classes will still be taking classes on *Zoom*. Holy Communion classes are still taking place, as normal.
- Confession.** Before each Mass, Saturdays 4—5 pm, or by appointment.
